This Feast serves as a bridge with the conclusion of the Christmas season and the First Sunday in Ordinary Time. The Baptism of the Lord is also a bridge from the childhood of Jesus to the start of his public ministry. Adult baptism was the normal form in the early church and marked the beginning of embracing Jesus in one's life as Lord and Saviour, and also inviting those who were baptised into public ministry by living a Christian life with words and deeds.

Today and for the past millennium 'infant' baptism has been the norm and the active faith required comes from the desire of parents. Parents act as the faith guardian of their children until they reach maturity.

That's why I love the Easter Vigil so much when we celebrate the baptism of adults and their personal faith that is shown to the community in such a wonderful and public way. Baptism has always meant 'action' and not just membership into a faith community.

This weekend let us renew our baptismal promise to be participants within God and the life we live. We are baptised into the death of Christ that we might be reborn with Him—thus the importance of recognising the 'cross' in our lives too!

North Korea tests a nuclear bomb, unhappy that every other country around the world only set off 'fire crackers' to welcome in the New Year. Such madness!!

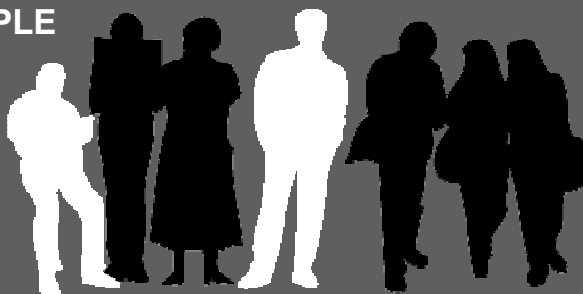
President Obama attempts to control the use and distribution of firearms in his own country that kills off Americans every year in senseless acts of evil.

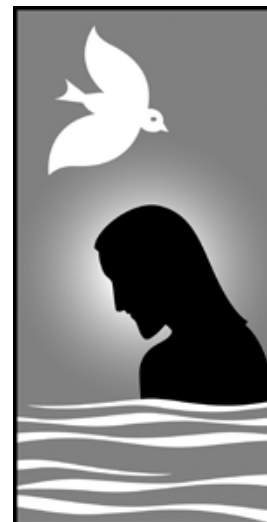
