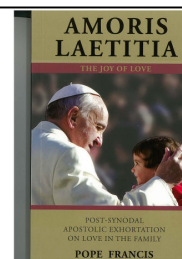
The Pope's next Book

Trinity Refugee Outreach (TRO)

Trinity Refugee Outreach (TRO) awareness team hosted a talk by Mohammad Ali Baqiri on May 17th in the McKenna Centre. Many who attended this night, found Mohammad Ali's personal story compelling and informative. He is a powerful campaigner for refugees and advocates against children being kept in detention centres.

Trinity Refugee Outreach have decided to support the work of BASP.

WHAT IS THE 'BRIGIDINE ASYLUM SEEKERS PROJECT (BASP)?'

It is an initiative sponsored by the Brigidine Sisters.

They engage with the issues of our time, stand in

solidarity with those who are oppressed, and seek to build a more inclusive community. Their motto is: **STRENGTH AND KINDNESS.**

BASP focus on practical assistance for people seeking asylum in Victoria. They offer advocacy and raise awareness of the issues asylum seekers face. BASP believe that government policies affecting many of those seeking protection in Australia are inhumane, unjust and punitive. They believe in a welcoming, inclusive and compassionate Australia.

BASP are in touch with people seeking asylum in immigration detention and in the community. They get to know asylum seekers, they befriend them in their quest for protection, they learn what they need, and they try to make it happen.

As BASP does not receive or seek government funding, they welcome financial support, goods and practical assistance. Trinity Refugee Outreach recommends that our communities support BASP by providing practical assistance, working as a volunteer, fund-raising and actively networking with them.

To support the work of BASP, Trinity Refugee Outreach is hosting a soup & roll luncheon to raise funds to send as a financial donation.

This will be held on Sunday, 5th June in the McKenna Centre at St Peters at 12pm.
