**Reflection:** Matthew writes this Gospel, telling us about the lessons that Jesus was trying to tell the multitudes that followed Him two thousand odd years ago, by using parables. Strangely enough those lessons or messages are still very relevant to our world today. They are good organic stories that are so simple to understand and yet ....

Ours is a world full of good people which is what it is intended to be, (the sowers good seed being sown in good soil). There are elements of bad people in our world (the darnel). They must grow beside each other, each one seeming to flourish and hold their own. Yet it is in the harvesting that the results of the differences become obvious, in what is reaped from what is sown and what becomes of each of their choices.

There's also the parable of the mustard seed, it seems like, if our actions, even the smallest ones are made with the right intentions, they can have a very rewarding flow on effect, which can more than fulfil its purpose, not only for us, but for those around us, (the birds of the air came to shelter in them).

Leaven according to the dictionary means to permeate, modify or transform for the better, this is what the yeast (Jesus teaching) does for us. It transforms us and grows within us.

Whether the kingdom of God is the here and now or the hereafter, (who knows?) we know one thing that He said, His way will take us there. *Cynthia White, Pastoral Leadership Team*

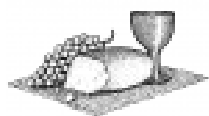
### **EUCCHARISTIC MINISTERS FORMATION**

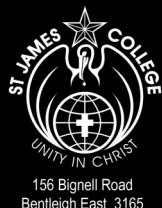

**THIS WEEK'S GOSPEL – Matthew 13: 24-43**

Jesus put a parable before the crowds, 'The kingdom of heaven may be compared to a man who sowed good seed in his field. While everybody was asleep his enemy came, sowed darnel all among the wheat, and made off. When the new wheat sprouted and ripened, the darnel appeared as well. The owner's servants went to him and said, "Sir, was it not good seed that you sowed in your field? If so, where does the darnel come from?" "Some enemy has done this" he answered. And the servants said, "Do you want us to go and weed it out?" But he said, "No, because when you weed out the darnel you might pull up the wheat with it. Let them both grow till the harvest; and at harvest time I shall say to the reapers: First collect the darnel and tie it in bundles to be burnt, then gather the wheat into my barn.'"

He put another parable before them, 'The kingdom of heaven is like a mustard seed which a man took and sowed in his field. It is the smallest of all the seeds, but when it has grown it is the biggest shrub of all and becomes a tree so that the birds of the air come and shelter in its branches.'

He told them another parable, 'The kingdom of heaven is like the yeast a woman took and mixed in with three measures of flour till it was leavened all through.'

In all this Jesus spoke to the crowds in parables; indeed, he would never speak to them except in parables. This was to fulfill the prophecy:

I will speak to you in parables  
and expound things hidden since the foundation of the world.

Then, leaving the crowds, he went to the house; and his disciples came to him and said, 'Explain the parable about the darnel in the field to us.' He said in reply, 'The sower of the good seed is the Son of Man. The field is the world; the good seed is the subjects of the kingdom; the darnel, the subjects of the evil one; the enemy who sowed them, the devil; the harvest is the end of the world; the reapers are the angels. Well then, just as the darnel is gathered up and burnt in the fire, so it will be at the end of time. The Son of Man will send his angels and they will gather out of his kingdom all things that provoke offences and all who do evil, and throw them into the blazing furnace, where there will be weeping and grinding of teeth. Then the virtuous will shine like the sun in the kingdom of their Father. Listen, anyone who has ears!'
