Reflection: Today's Gospel is a reason for both personal and community reflection. Which God do we believe in? Is he the one of the "wise" or the one revealed to us by Jesus?

In today's society we may feel overwhelmed by the world and our responsibilities. We may find even our efforts to grow in the most important relationships of our lives, such as family, with people and God, difficult and challenging. Our world is a place where many are being exploited by drugs, alcohol and violence; and all are exposed to images of turmoil and terrorism everywhere. It is in these times of uncertainties that we are being challenged by Jesus who says, "Come to me for I am meek and humble of heart and I know how you feel. Entrust yourself and your burdens to me.

I will care for you and your family. I am God, but I have not distanced myself from you."

Our faith is not about praying away our problems or fears and wishing it were otherwise. Our faith means we have experienced the love of God in Jesus Christ and we know that we are not alone in our difficult times. God is our companion and guide; and our parish Community, as with every Christian community, is called to a fresh view of the world and a new way of living. We need to come back to Jesus and his invitation to share the load.

Jesus is a tangible person, our accepting of him as the manifestation of God requires faith, and this faith is no easier today than it was at the time of Jesus himself.

This week we will farewell our dear friend and parishioner Ann Dodd who is known in our 3 communities. Her pastoral care touched many of us as a friend and pastoral carer, especially when we were challenged by life difficulties. Ann faced her own, in the last 3 years, with much courage and faith.

Ann was a *tangible person* accepting of what God asked of her, a living example of God's presence in our lives.

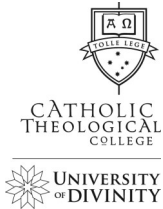

For your information, I leave Thursday 3rd. August and return on Friday 24th.

The planned Sabbatical time starts Monday 4th. September at PNAC, Pontifical North American College – the actual address for letters is: Institute for Continuing Theological Education, North American College, 00120 Vatican City State, EUROPE (don't put Rome) Email:romeshabat@pnac.org - attention: Michael Sierakowski
Three Modules in 3 Months:

Papal States: the History Art & Architecture of Rome and the surrounding Papal states. Naturally this includes St. Peters in Rome, Perugia, Orvieto, Spoleto, Narni, Viterbo, and Anagni, Tours of various important Palaces in our history: Doria Pamphilj, Quirinale, Braschi! The Tour guides and lectures are given by University Professors and those who specialize in these areas and who live locally!

Saints in Rome: Mass and Tours at the tombs of key figures in the life of Jesus and beyond. These include the Tomb of St. Peter, The SCAVI, the Catacombs along with the life and basilicas of San Clemente, St. Mary Major, St. Philip Neri, San Lorenzo, St. Aloysius Gonzaga, St. Andrea al Quirinale, St. Ignatius, St. Paul, St. Josemaria Escriva, St. John Paul II – just to name a few! Thus plenty of visits and professors to share stories about these great figures!

Life of the Priest: This topic includes, the Spirituality of Preaching, Building Catholic Leaders, Parish Based Evangelization, Evangelii Gaudium and Pope Francis, Giving witness to God in our lives, The Pastor as CEO, Canon Law Update and the Gift of Priestly Ministry, plus a retreat for Priests in Ars, France! Naturally, various Spiritual Directors will accompany us on this very personal journey. These topics I will enjoy very much!!

In the Month of August, I plan to Fly into **London** for my first 10 days, and visit some old friends while there. Then onto the spiritual centre of 'Taize' for a week's retreat in central France! **Taize** is a favourite place for me, and I will be joined by Mark & Josie Lampe for this special week, and finally from August 20th. till September 3rd. I will have 2 weeks in **Paris** – enjoying the Café culture and hopefully visiting 'Villers-Bretonneux' – the site where some Eleven thousand Australian Soldiers lost their life in WW1. The Australian National Memorial is at the Military Cemetery and next year marks this Centenary - Anzac Day 2018!

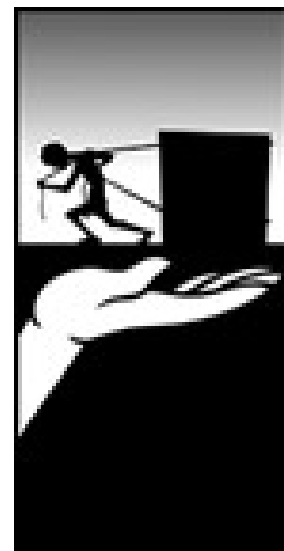
