We deeply respect the Aboriginal Community of Bunnerong upon whose land our parish resides.**Reflection:**

Today's Gospel of Matthew is the first explicit encounter of Jesus and his disciples with a non-Jew, a Gentile woman. The story intensifies the surprise and shock we can feel as we hear Jesus' exchange with the Canaanite woman. This woman, approaches Jesus, requesting that he heal her demon-possessed daughter. At first Jesus ignores her and says nothing. The disciples ask Jesus to send her away, and Jesus agrees, remarking that he was sent to minister to the Jews alone. The woman could have walked away from Jesus for not accepting her but she turns Jesus' insult into an affirmation of faith.

Moved by her remarkable faith, Jesus is forced beyond the limited confines of his own cultural experience. He agrees to her wishes and heals her daughter. Despite his initial abruptness and reluctance, Jesus had a change of heart towards this Gentile woman and responds with compassion to the woman's request. It is as though she needed to demonstrate that she was really serious and that she did in fact believe that Jesus could make a difference in her life and the life of her daughter. Just as Jesus was surprised by the faith expressed by the Canaanite woman, so too the first Christians were surprised that the Gentiles would receive the salvation God offered through Christ.

Through this act of healing Jesus affirmed that He had been sent to institute "a house of prayer for all people." His Kingdom that is on earth now and what is to come was not meant for only one people; it was meant for all races and nations.

On Behalf of "OLSH Overseas Aid" I want to say "Thank you" to all our friends and benefactors who responded so generously to our 'Famine Appeal', and to those who regularly contribute to Overseas Aid, especially the Bread Ministry team and Pat who makes the jams & relishes. Our two Australian OLSH Sisters, Wendy and Rita are still working heroically in tragic circumstances.

Sr Wendy writes: "There are 68 old or infirm ladies, unable to come to us, to whom we have food delivered each week, as well as many more who come to our compound. People bring things to sell us – firewood, bundles of grass, bamboo poles . . . we pay with food – money is worthless. . . ."

From Sr Rita: "It is difficult trying to respond to all who present themselves at our gate. Severe hunger, but not yet real starvation, thanks to donors who continue to make 'warding off starvation' possible. All who come get something. Blessings on donors who give hope to our people.. . ."

THIS WEEK'S GOSPEL – Matthew 15: 21-28

He said in reply, 'I was sent only to the lost sheep of the House of Israel.' But the woman had come up and was kneeling at his feet. 'Lord,' she said 'help me.' Then Jesus answered her, 'Woman, you have great faith. Let your wish be granted.' And from that moment her daughter was well again.
