As we celebrate the Feasts of St. Vincent de Paul and Blessed Frederic Ozanam (founder of the Society) during the month of September, our Conference decided to share with all Parishioners the work of the Moorabbin/Bentleigh Conference. The St. Catherine's Moorabbin Conference has been in operation around 20 years, with St. Paul's Bentleigh Conference joining us around 10 years ago. The Conference consists of 13 members, we visit in pairs and share the monthly roster, mostly on call for one week in the month.

The needs of the Moorabbin/Bentleigh areas have certainly changed over the years with more single male and female adults needing help, and not so many families, and with most on disability pensions. We now have a number of boarding/rooming houses that accommodate people in small rooms, sharing kitchen and bathrooms, and paying \$200 per week for a room which is poorly furnished.

Over the past year (2016), we have visited 466 homes, and given out a total of approximately \$27,925 in Supermarkets Vouchers. We have assisted in helping with Rent, Utilities, Chemist, and White Goods, to the total of well over \$10,500. With every visit we make, we provide a bag of non-perishable food, of which some has been donated and some we have purchased. We find that most people we visit are struggling to cope with daily financial, medical, and emotional problems. Most are lonely, have no other family support, they welcome us into their homes and share their concerns with us. Sometimes we are the only person they have spoken to that day, so our call helps in many ways...Supermarkets Vouchers, Food and Friendship.

We would not function without the help of all our Parishioners, who always respond so willingly to our call for donations. To the Crafty Ladies, who work so hard, create amazing, beautiful craft, woollen throws, and delicious cakes. We are most grateful for the time, effort and planning that goes into your Mother's Day, Father's Day and Christmas Stalls, the result of which raises funds to help us purchase Supermarket Vouchers. We also recognise St. Catherine's and St. Paul's Primary Schools, O.L.S.H. College Bentleigh, and Tucker Road Primary School, for their support for our Winter and Christmas appeals. A "big" thank you for your continued support.

Our "big effort" for the year is our Christmas Hampers. Last year (2016) we delivered 72 Hampers to single people and families, most of whom we visit throughout the year. Much planning and organising is needed, but without the help of the Parishioners, Schools, and Crafty Ladies we could not achieve this.

We also help out on a Saturday every 6/7 weeks at the Hampton Vinnies Store. The Hampton Vinnies Shop provides funds for our Conference and also 5 other Conferences in the Region.

The members of St. Vincent de Paul Moorabbin/Bentleigh Conference wish to thank "All" for your generous donations throughout the year, enabling us to continue our important work, helping those suffering hardships and trying to make ends meet.

Our Conference meets fortnightly throughout the year, in the Sweeney Centre at St. Catherine's Church at 7.00pm. If you are interested, you are most welcome to join our friendly group.
